#1 - Where do you want to go?



#2 – What is the type of <u>water</u> for the trip?

Ocean Bay?



Moving Water?

Lake or Pond?

What *water* hazards or characteristics should be considered?

- •Open water or small, protected area? Tides? Wind? Waves?
- •Water temperature?
- •Flow conditions? Classification of the river?
- Dams, undercuts, frequent strainers, known rapids, holes?

#4 – What are likely weather conditions?



• Internet

- 24-Hour phone lines
- •Newspapers



#5 – What are likely <u>on-land</u> conditions?

- Insects, reptiles & mammals of concern *and* of interest
- •Rocky, desert, ice, snow, clay, wooded...
- •Tamarisk blockage
- •Rowdy party area
- •Cliff camping
- •Trains



#6 – Laws & Restrictions?

- •Club waivers, Parental permission, ACA insurance...
- •Toilets, Trash, Fires, Cooking
- •Fishing, Firearms, Alcohol, Glass containers
- •Number in party, ages, pets...see #7 too!
- •Are there boat gear requirements governed by local agencies?



#7 – WHO

- •Who is coming?
- •What skills do they need?
- •Do I know them or do I know someone who knows them?
- •What questions do I need to ask to understand their experience or lack thereof?



#8 – Basic Planning Questions

- •Who has their own boat, who needs a partner?
- How do I contact everyone during the planning & organizing phase?
- •Do we need pre-trip training or a meeting?



#9 – More Planning Logistics

- •Meeting Place
- •How do we get there?
- •Reservations
- •Permits / Park Passes
- •Cell Phone List
- •Local Emergency List
- •Home Emergency List



#10 – Equipment

- •Discuss Group equipment vs. Individual Equipment.
- •What equipment is REQUIRED for the group and individuals?
- •Pass out equipment list examples. Compile your own lists, or use some from your club, and include special items such as child and pet needs.



#11 – The Put-In Talk

- •Group Introductions
- •Confirm weather, water, required equipment
- •Confirm permits, documentation
- •Review plan for the day, segment, trip
- •Car keys, cell phones safely stowed
- •Count # boats



#12 – The Put-In SAFETY Talk

- •PFD Fit, helmets
- •Rescue situations Responsibilities of rescuers and victims
- •Whistle and Paddle/Arm signals
- •Buddy boats, boat order



•Scouting, landmarks, group communication

#13 – Before you do this, ask yourself...

- •Am I willing to speak up to individuals who put the group at risk?
- •What skills do I lack that concern me about this trip?
- •Can I team up with someone who has skills to complement my weak areas?
- •Is there anyone else along that has special skills to enlist as needed?
